SUGGESTED ITEMS FOR INPATIENT ADMISSION

- 3 sets of clothing, underwear and socks with no strings or ties (washer and dryer accessible on unit with detergent provided)
- 2 set of nightwear/pajamas
- Comb, hairbrush, up to 2 hair ties with no metal clasps
- Unopened oral and eye care Items toothbrush, toothpaste, denture cup, contact solution (denture cleaner and contact solution not supplied by hospital)
- Unopened deodorant (non-aerosol)
- Unopened shampoo/conditioner/body wash
- Sweater or Jacket recommended due to fluctuating temperatures
- · Small amounts of jewelry (wedding band, small post earrings) are allowed
- · Unopened packs of cigarettes

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED ON THE UNIT DUE TO SAFETY ISSUES

- Outside food, candy, gum and drinks
- Electronics or recording devices (cell phones and watches will be secured in patient locker with limited access)
- · Glass, metal containers and mirrors
- Aerosol sprays (including shaving cream), flammable liquids, lighters and matches
- Vapes, cigars and chewing tobacco
- · Weapons including guns, knives and ammunition
- · Scissors and nail clippers
- Pornographic materials
- Drugs and drug paraphernalia
- · Personal hygiene products which are opened or contain alcohol in the first 3 ingredients
- · Picture frames (pictures without frames are permitted)
- Rope, yarn, shoe strings, belts, leashes and hosiery
- Scarves, headbands, hair clips
- Spiral-bound notebook and books with attached ribbon
- · Clothing that is tight-fitting/revealing
- · Clothing that contains gang, drug, alcohol, profanity or racial related messages
- Blankets, pillows and stuffed animals
- Art supplies

The following items may be used under supervision at the discretion of the treatment team:

- Unopened disposable razor
- · Electric razor, hair dryers, curling and flat irons after inspection
- Musical instruments
- · Cosmetics in non-glass containers
